

Musical Artistic Education Project.

The present is a musical education project for children and young people, conceived as a proposal for artistic development that also contributes to the integral formation of the person and the cultural development of the community; combining the participation of various agents and resources of different origins for their realization.

Objectives.

The project seeks to harness the talent and artistic skills of children and young people, offering them the possibility to develop them through musical education and the execution of an instrument. The importance of music education lies in its ability to stimulate cognitive skills such as attention, mental agility, memory, auditory perception, creativity, fine psychomotority and aesthetic sensitivity. It also promotes social skills such as organization, personal expression, self-esteem and teamwork. It also consolidates values such as respect for others and harmonious integration within a group.

With the skills generated, students will form a basic musical grouping, as a first fruit of the participants' work and a cultural contribution to the community.

Beneficiaries.

The target audience of the project is on young people and children in the district of San Juan Bautista, from the age of 11.

Organization and execution.

The proposal would be made thanks to the alliance between the Parish **of San Juan Bautista de Miraflores** and the Civil Association Eco **Acordes**. The main contribution of the first would be to allow the use of some environments of its facilities for the realization of activities; while Eco Chords will be responsible for providing human resources and musical instruments for the implementation of the project.

Activities.

The following actions will be carried out to launch the project:

- Dissemination of the proposal to the community and the general public.
- Sessions for the presentation of the instruments and the proposal to young people interested in the parish hall.
- Dynamic and participatory teaching-learning activities during the business days of the week.
- Instrument practice sessions.

The activities will observe the biosecurity measures stipulated by the government during this health situation, with small groups organized.

In addition, the teaching-learning work of music will be based on psychopedagogic strategies, aimed at the integral development of young people. Other artistic and environmental education activities can be offered as a complement to them.

Costs and scholarships:

Teaching-learning sessions, one and a half hours long, will have a referencing cost of ten suns per session; the total monthly cost may be changed, depending on the number of weekly hours agreed between the student and the teacher.

Additionally, Eco Chords will manage comprehensive scholarships for outstanding students who could not afford the costs of the music education program. These scholarships will include a musical instrument for the scholarship student.
